



## Notion Commotion

### Quilting

The teachers at *Sew You Can* recommend that you bring the following quilting notions to every class:

#### For regular quilting classes:

- sewing machine with foot pedal and power cord
- sewing machine manual
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot with guide
- walking foot
- extra sewing machine needles (probably sz. 80/12)
- extra bobbins
- neutral thread (for piecing)
- small thread snips or scissors
- scissors
- 45 mm rotary cutter with extra blades
- seam ripper
- stiletto
- screwdriver
- straight pins
- magnetic pin holder or pin cushion
- rulers
- measuring tape - 120"
- mechanical pencil with eraser
- regular pen
- sharpie marker - fine or extra fine
- fabric pencil for light and dark—microtip (Fons & Porter)
- sizing and/or starch
- small notebook
- calculator
- band-aids
- aspirin/Tylenol/Advil
- chocolate

#### For appliqué classes:

- open-toe appliqué machine foot
- sz. 70/10 or 75/11 machine needles—microtex/sharp
- self-threading hand-sewing needles
- tweezers
- appliqué pins (these are fine and long—often have the little flat flower on the end)
- any special appliqué scissors
- glue stick
- various sizes of Ziploc bags
- colored thread (for appliqué technique)
- small iron
- pressing mat
- non-stick pressing sheet
