



## **Sew Cool After School**

Sewing School for Kids 9—14

Have you always wanted to learn to sew? Have you seen cool things that your friends have made? Join the Sew Cool After School program and learn introductory sewing techniques in a fun and positive environment. You'll start with basic sewing then build those skills in weekly sessions.

You'll sign up for a weekday and will be in class with the same group of sewing rebels all month.

**TIME:** All sessions run from 3:15pm to 5:15 pm

**DATES:** Runs weekly - January 12, 19, 26, and February 2

**SESSIONS:** Tuesdays

**TOTAL DURATION:** 8 hours

**TOTAL ENROLLMENT:** 4 kids per session

**COST:** \$80 for the month—includes some supplies (student will be responsible for materials for some classes)

**INSTRUCTOR:** Bia Bernum

### **SUPPLIES:**

Sewing Machine and Manual (or use one of our machines)

Sewing Notions: thread, bobbins, good scissors (small and larger), 45mm rotary cutter, needles (size 12/80)\*, pins, cloth measuring tape, sewing gauge\*, magnetic seam guide\*, and disappearing marker (these are blue or purple).

We DO NOT recommend purchasing a pre-made kit. The notions are typically low-end and are not sharp.

We also recommend that you keep your notions in a container with a lid - many students use a small to medium sized tackle box.

Project supplies will vary. Students will be told what they need to purchase for the next class.

## Class Schedule and Supply List:

### Session ONE:

We'll review the basics of a sewing machine and then you'll practice sewing on paper then fabric. We'll experiment with different stitches, practice rotary cutting, and make a book marker!

*BRING TO CLASS:* Fabric for your pillow case. Please wash all fabric prior to class. You can purchase this fabric at JoAnn Fabrics. When you walk in the store take a sharp left. It's along the wall and in some of the aisles. You can also purchase this at a local quilt shop.

- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard - main fabric - cotton quilting-weight fabric
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yard - edge fabric - cotton quilting-weight fabric
- $\frac{1}{8}$  yard - contrasting band - cotton quilting-weight fabric
- Matching thread
- All of your sewing notions

### Session TWO:

*BRING TO CLASS:* Fabric for your Tote bag. Please wash all fabric prior to class.

- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of denim fabric - any color - for exterior - avoid stretchy denim
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of cotton quilting-weight fabric for lining
- Matching thread
- Your class binder
- All of your sewing notions

*BRING TO CLASS:* Fabric for your Drawstring Bag. Please wash all fabric prior to class.

- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of cotton quilting-weight fabric for exterior
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of cotton quilting-weight fabric for lining
- Matching thread
- Your class binder
- All of your sewing notions
